Benefits of pheromone trap are:

- Used as a tool to monitor adult moth activity
- Determines which insect species is present
- Allows for decisions to be made on the basis of moth numbers

Trap Assembly Instructions

Complete pheromone trap requires

- 1 x trap body & hanger;
- 1 x sticky base (glue insert);
- 1 x insect pheromone lure

Place assembled trap at least 1.5 metres above the ground. A minimum of one trap per 2 hectares is required for effective monitoring. Replace sticky base at least every 3 weeks and pheromone lure every 6 weeks.
